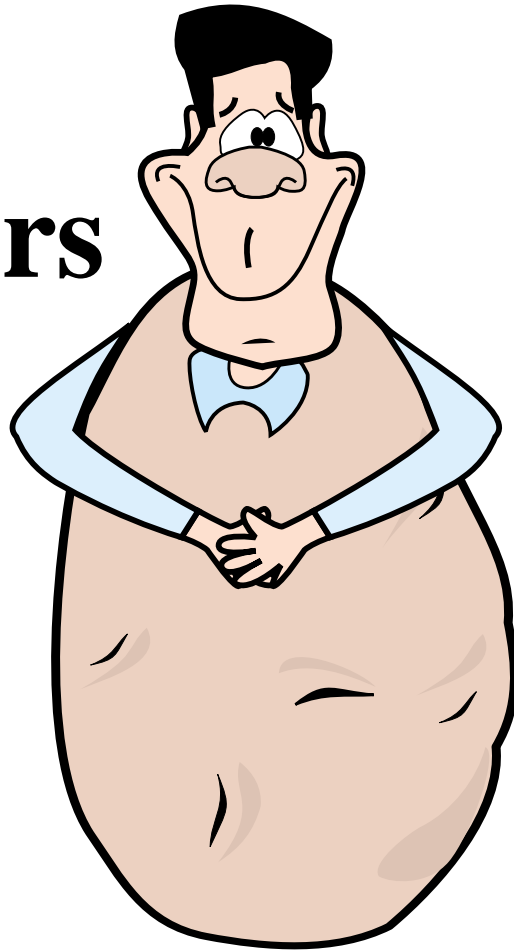

## HESITATORS

Lot and his family to leave Sodom (Genesis 19:16)  
10 spies with fearful report about Canaan (Numbers 13:27,28)  
King Saul to destroy the goods of the Amalikites (I Samuel 15:9)  
Agrippa to become a Christian (Acts 26:28)

## IMITATORS

Ahaziah copied the evil ways of his fathers (I Kings 22:51-53)  
Israelites wanting a king (I Samuel 8:4,5)  
Ananias and Saphira copied each other's deceit (Acts 5:1-10)

## ROTATORS

Lot's wife looked back (Genesis 19:26)  
Disciples, who left Jesus alone in the garden (Matthew 26:56)  
Elijah fled from the wrath of Jezebel (I Kings 19:3,4)

## AGITATORS

Dathan & Abiram (Numbers 26:9)  
Haaman to the Jews (Esther 3:5,6)  
Paul to the church before his conversion (Acts 8:3)

## DICTATORS

Pharoah (Exodus 5:6,7)  
Darius with his decree (Daniel 6:7-9)  
Herod at the time of Christ's birth (Matthew 2:16)

## IRRITATORS

Young boys who teased Elisha about baldness (II Kings 2:23)  
Those who opposed Nehemiah and the workers (Nehemiah 4:6-8)  
Girl who accused Peter in the courtyard (Luke 22:55-60)  
Unrepentent thief on the cross (Luke 23:39)

## SPECTATORS

King Saul at the challenge of Goliath (I Samuel 17:55)  
Pharisees and others who watched Jesus but did not believe (Matthew 3:7; John 10:37,38)  
Paul before his conversion watching Stephen's stoning (Acts 7:58,59)

## MEDITATORS

Daniel praying daily (Daniel 6:10)  
David repeatedly in the Psalms (Psalm 119:97)  
Jesus coming apart to pray (Matthew 14:23)

## SWEET TATERS

Abigail (I Samuel 25:3)  
Esther (Esther 2:17)  
Mary the mother of Christ (Luke 1:28)  
Maid who told Naaman of Elisha (II Kings 5:2,3)  
Jesus being obedient unto death (Philippians 2:8)

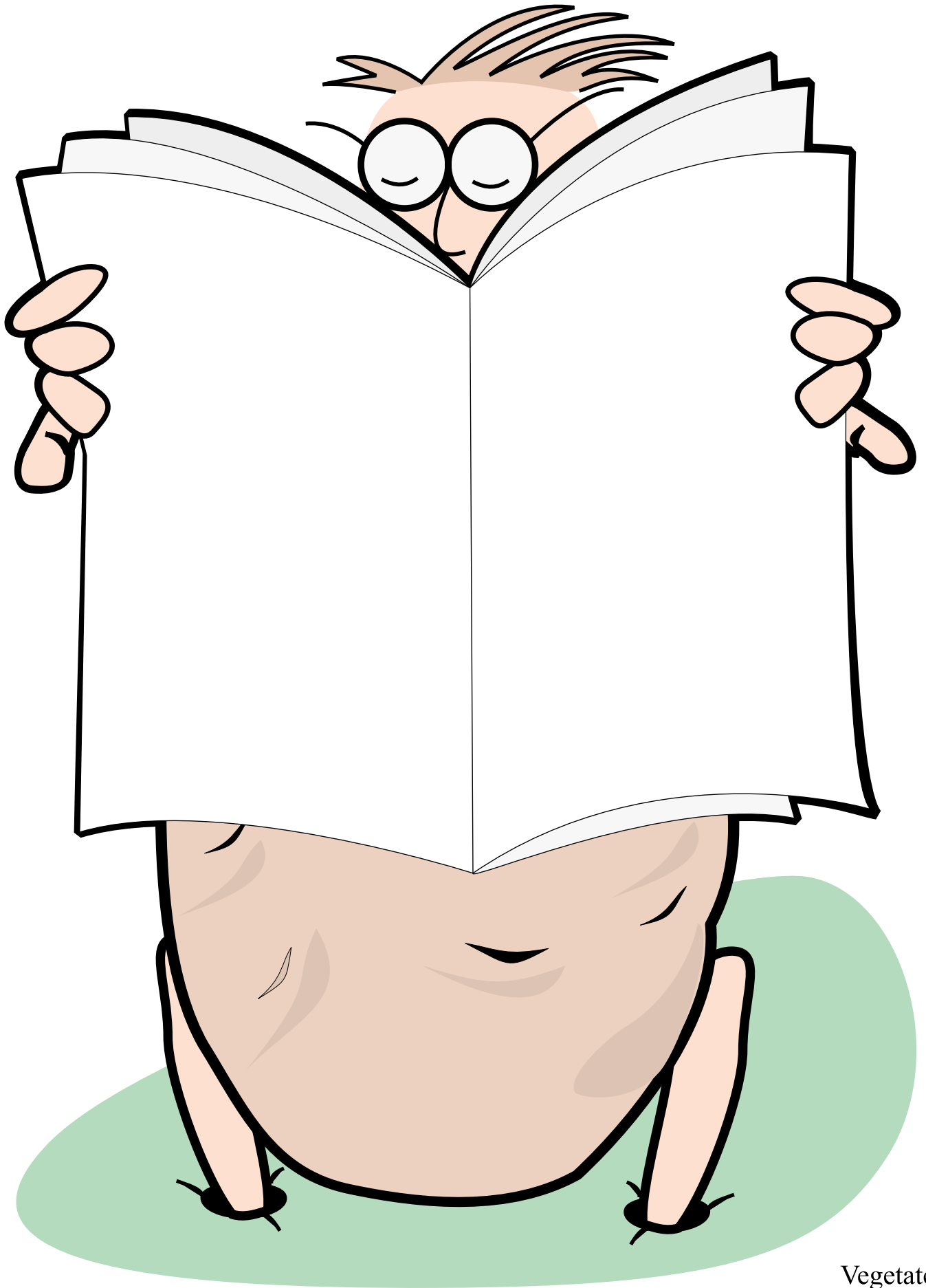

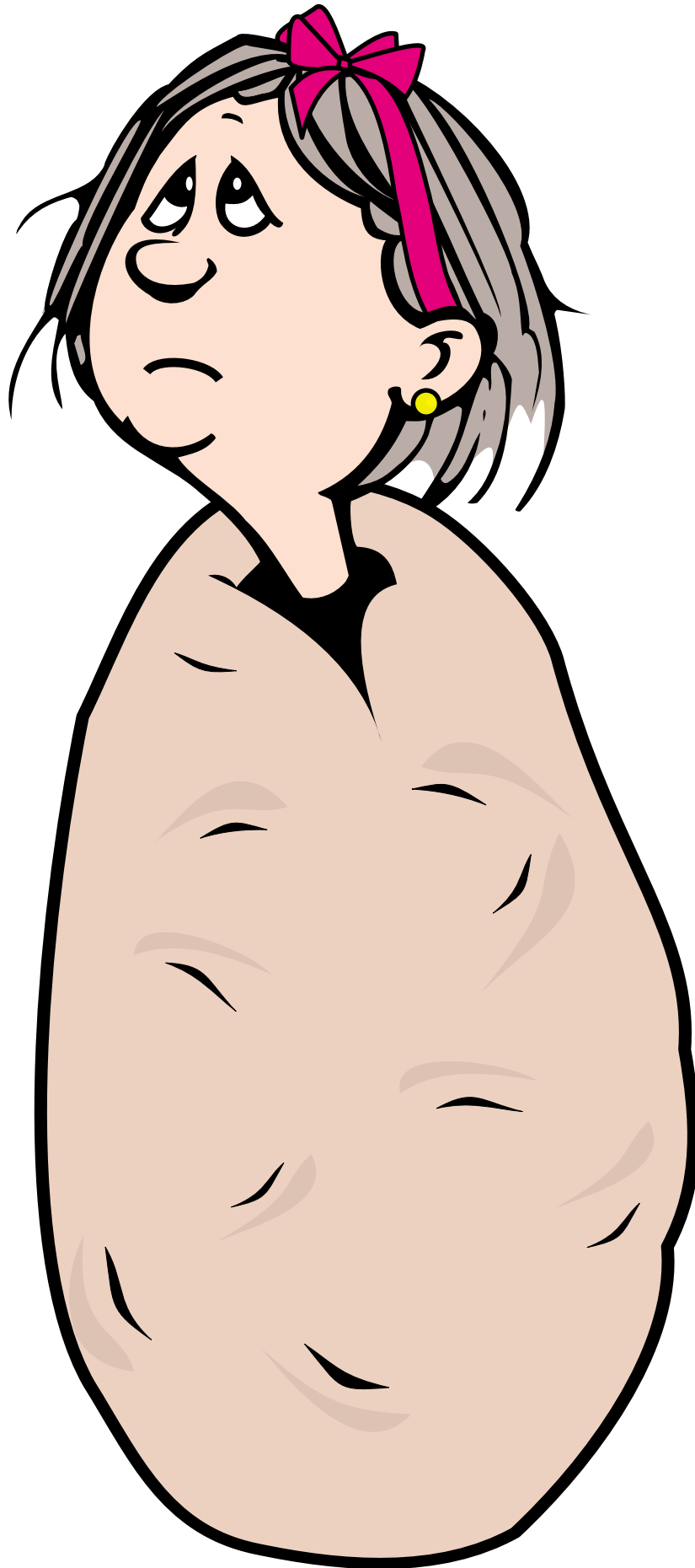

Their words were all they had to give, no hands to help their peers.

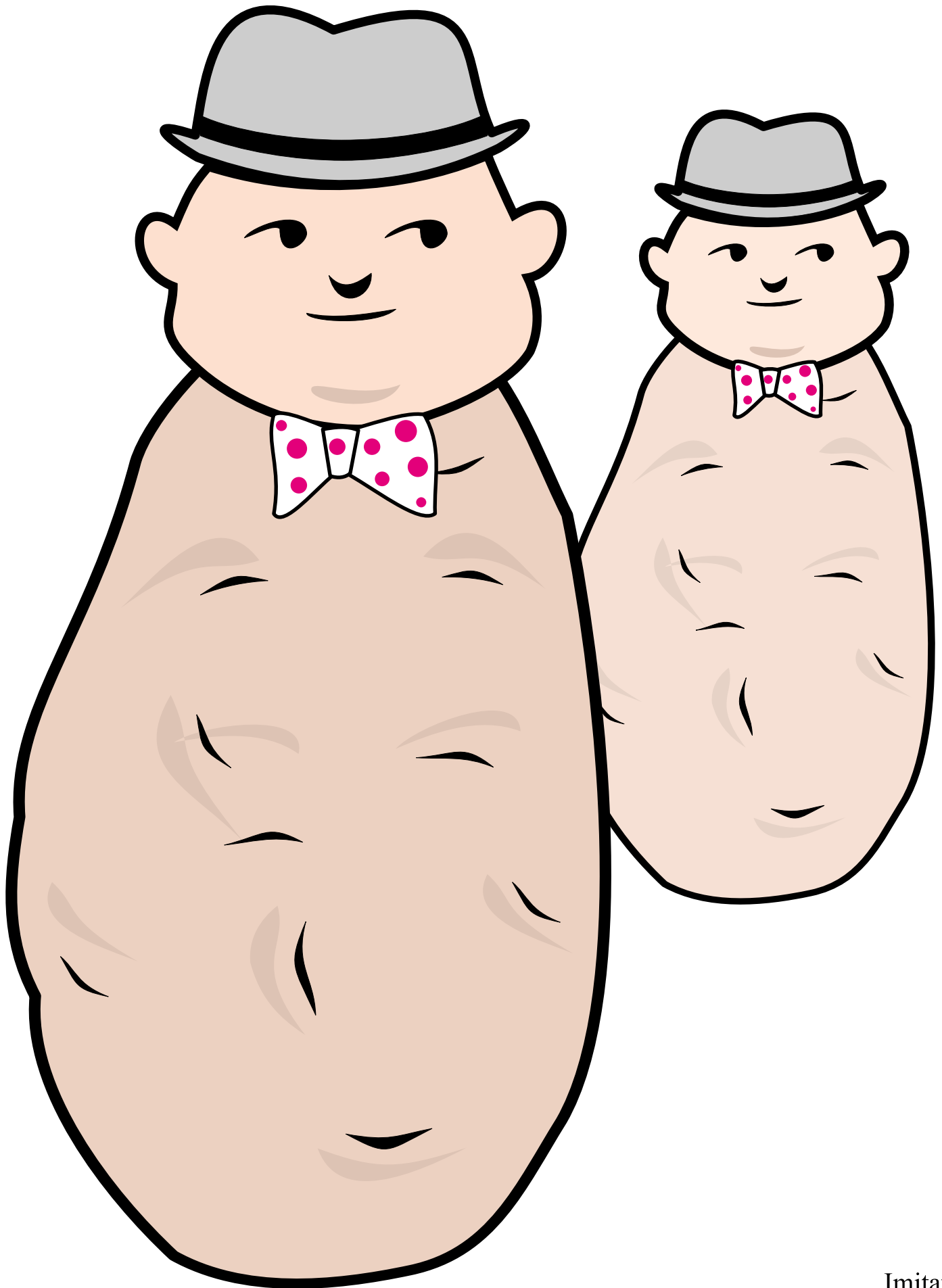
Then gentle and refreshing as a cooling summer breeze,

And as they sang of Jesus' love, SWEET TATERS they became.



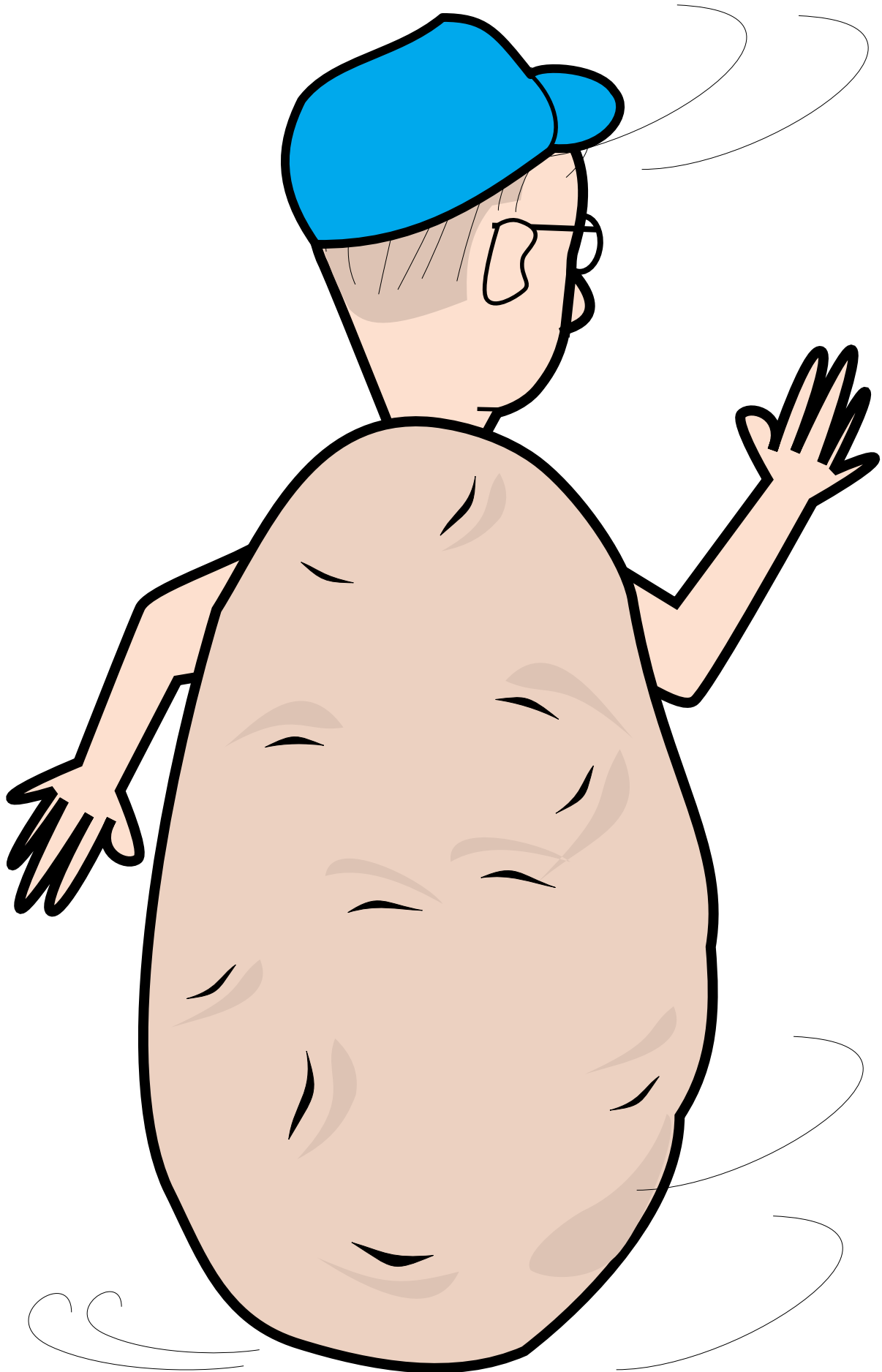
